CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 1 NAME

Section 1 The organization shall be known as The Rebounders Club.

ARTICLE 2 PURPOSE

Section 1 To promote and support The Ohio State University's Women's Basketball program and to foster national and international amateur sports competition.

Section 2 To strive for increasing awareness of the program on the local, state and national level.

Section 3 To increase and maintain a viable, enthusiastic membership.

Section 4 To attend as many home and away games as possible.

Section 5 To raise monies, through dues and fund raisers, to support activities, and to foster national and international amateur sports competition to be in compliance with our Corporation as required under the laws of the State of Ohio.

ARTICLE 3 MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 Membership shall be open to all interested persons regardless of race, religion, or national origin.

Section 2 All members of the Organization are governed by this Constitution and By-Laws. This does not preclude the right of any individual member to refuse to support positions or actions of the Organization.

ARTICLE 4 OFFICERS AND FUNCTIONAL BODIES

Section 1 The officers of the Organization shall be President, President-Elect, Immediate Past- President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Section 2 There shall be an Executive Board.

Section 3 There shall be standing and special committees as may be established by the Executive Board.

Section 4 The Executive Board shall adopt and publish standing rules which govern its conduct and are consistent with Laws of Ohio, the Constitution and By-Laws.

ARTICLE 5 DISBURSEMENTS OF ASSETS

Section 1 In the event The Rebounders Club would cease to exist, the entire Treasury balance and assets would be donated to The Ohio State University Development Fund for the women's basketball program.

ARTICLE 6 AMENDMENTS

- Section 1 A proposed amendment to this Constitution must be presented to all members at least ten (10) days prior to the date of voting.
- Section 2 This Constitution may be amended by 75% of the active membership, in attendance, who vote according to the procedures described in The Rebounders Club By-Laws.
- Section 3 Special meetings may be called by the President or by the written request of a majority of the Executive Board, or by the written request of 15% of the membership. Upon receipt of the request for a special meeting, the Secretary shall send immediately a written notice to all members stating the time, place, and the business to be considered. No other business shall be transacted at this meeting except that stated in the call.
- Section 4 The members of the Organization in attendance shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting.
- Section 5 Seventy-five (75) percent of officers and chairpersons is required to constitute a quorum for the transactions of business at any Executive Board meetings.
